

The Florida A&M University's (FAMU) Graduate Feeder Program is an arrangement with 47 degree-granting institutions across the country. OGD reserves five financial aid packages annually for qualified FAMU graduates from all academic disciplines who wish to pursue a PhD. It provides a base stipend of \$12,000, in-state tuition, fees and health insurance for up to five years.

Deadline: The FAMU Feeder application deadline is April 23, 2018, in anticipation of accepting the fellowship award in Fall 2018. All application materials must be received by the Office of Graduate Diversity Initiatives by the deadline date to be considered.

Support materials that must be attached to your application:

- **Personal statement**
- **Copy of your official graduate school acceptance letter**
- **Unofficial Transcript**

Notification: All applicants will be notified whether or not they received the FAMU Feeder fellowship by electronic mail and/or letter through the U.S. Postal Service. Please allow up to three weeks after application deadline for processing of your application.
